1. To co-opt a new parish councillor

After advertising a casual vacancy, Jacqueline Newton was co-opted as a member of the parish council. She agreed to become the PC representative on the village hall committee.

Proposed by Cllr Cleverly, seconded Cllr Hawes. All in favour.

2. To approve the cost of structural survey of village garden wall by David Vestey (Croft Surveyors Ltd)

To be charged at £140/hour plus disbursements and VAT but will not exceed £350 plus VAT (£420) for this initial report.

After some discussion about the condition of the wall it was agreed to carry out the survey. While there is no clarity about ownership of the wall and the allocation of the cost of any possible future remedial work, the PC felt it was important to understand the state of the wall and any risks to users of the garden.
